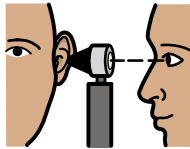
The doctor may wish to examine me.

The doctor may examine my belly.



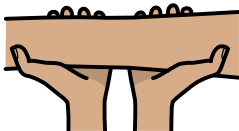
The doctor may look in my ears.



The doctor may ask me to open my mouth.



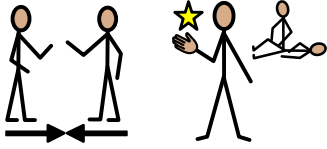
The doctor may look at my skin.



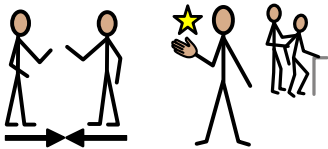

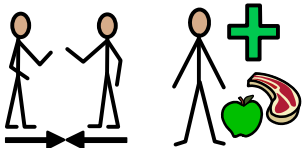

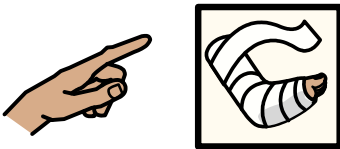

I may meet an occupational therapist.



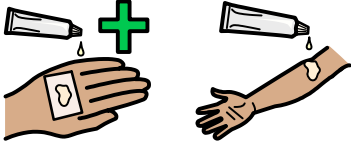
